



Jenny Balfour Paul, writer, artist, curator, international lecturer and traveller, is an alumni and Honorary Research Fellow at Exeter University; Fellow, Councillor and Trustee of the Royal Geographical Society; Fellow of the Royal Asiatic Society and New York's Explorers Club; President of the UK's Association of Guilds of Weavers, Spinners and Dyers and a partner in 'Silk Road Connect', an educational initiative launched by cellist Yo Yo Ma's Silk Road Project in New York in 2009,

Author of *Indigo in the Arab World*, *Indigo: Egyptian Mummies to Blue Jeans* and *Deeper than Indigo: tracing Thomas Machell, forgotten explore*, she was consultant curator for the Whitworth Art gallery's 2007 touring exhibition 'Indigo, a Blue to Dye For' and consultant for two documentary films on Indigo.

She researches dyes recovered from shipwrecks and promotes revivals of natural dyes worldwide. Her collections of Arab and indigo-dyed textiles and related artefacts are held in major UK museums.
